Who are we?



We are a grassroots environmental charity working to bring rivers and their catchments back to life.

Our mission is to deliver outstanding ecosystem enhancement through science-based action collaboration, education and engagement.

We work with local communities to deliver high quality river and catchment enhancement projects, improving the health of our rivers for both people and wildlife

Activities

River Cleanups

Rubbish in our rivers is a big problem. Not only is it unsightly, it also has a huge environmental impact; harming wildlife and leaking chemicals and pollutants into the water. If it's not picked up, it often makes its way into our oceans where it can persist for hundreds of years, damaging marine ecosystems and even ending up in our food chain as micro-plastics.

This full day activity is not a normal litter pick! Don waders and get into the the river to help remove everything from shopping trolleys to mattresses.

Suitable for 15-20 people

River restoration

Rivers have been modified by humans for thousands of years for agriculture, , industry and flood prevention. Unfortunately this often has a detrimental impact to the way rivers function and the available habitat for wildlife.

If you fancy getting some hands on experience of how we work to improve river habitats, join us to restore and re-wiggle a river!

This type of event usually takes place over multiple days so is ideal for groups who are happy to split into smaller teams.

Cost: Project dependent, please enquire for more details.

Suitable for 10 -15 people per day over 2-3 days.

Invasive Plant Management

Plants like Himalayan balsam and pennywort are invasive species that spread rapidly, covering river banks and waterways. They prevent other plants from growing and have a negative impact on river function and native wildlife.

Pulling or cutting these plants by hand is the best method of control so we need your help to tackle it! This is a fun, hands on team activity, with options to work from the bank or in the river in waders.

Cost: £2000 + VAT

Suitable for 15-30 people

Guided Walks and Talks

Want to learn more about your local river but don't fancy a practical event?

Our knowledgeable staff can pay a visit to your office, or lead your team on a guided walk to help you get to know your local river, the issues it faces and the work we are doing to improve it.

Cost: from £400 + VAT

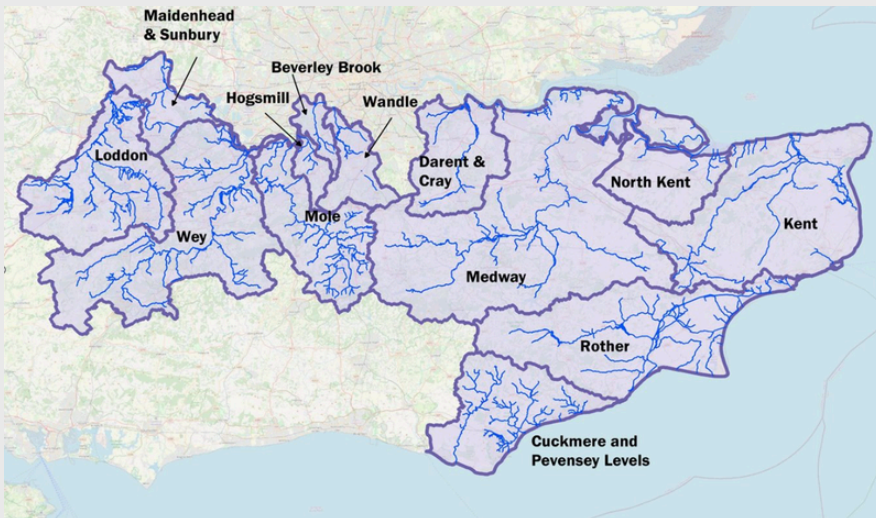
Other Activities
